Travel and lodging are provided for teachers selected to attend NSTI who reside more than 50 miles from the venue.

The program combines training and team-based projects to increase teacher knowledge of invention, innovation and entrepreneurship. The primary focus of NSTI is on the creation and protection of intellectual property.
